
The Lodge at Fishtail, Montana






The lodge is located at the boundary of the Custer National Forest in the middle of some of nature's most amazing vistas. The unspoiled wilderness provides nature lovers with loads of things to do. The area provides numerous places to hike, bike, and white water raft, or just relax and enjoy nature and take in the views.

For those who enjoy fishing, there are many great spots near the lodge, such as Mystic Lake and the Stillwater river for great fly fishing. For those who prefer a guided fishing trip, there are



outfiters and fishing supply stores that will make a visitor's dream fishing trip a reality. For those who want to see nature from a different perspective there is always horse back riding and let's not forget there is golf for those that can not live without that little white ball.



Hunters will find a plethora of game including mountain lions, elk, mule, white tail deer, bear, and moose. Wildlife cameras around the lodge show shots of numerous different species of animals that have crossed their paths.

Winter sport enthusiasts can enjoy cross-country skiing or snow shoeing on property or will find destinations, such as the Red Lodge Mountain, within a one hour drive that provide activities including downhill skiing, snow boarding, snowmobiling and more.



The lodge is located in the "Yellowstone Country." As the name implies the region is close to Yellowstone National Park, which is one of the top five National Parks in the country. It has many natural attractions such as the famous geyser "Old Faithful," Mammoth Hot Springs, Norris Geyser Basin, Fountain Paint Pot, West Thumb Geyser Basin, and many other natural point of interest.
