Wolves travel frequently from Yellow Stone Park to the lodge area, so don't be surprised if you wake up in the morning and see wolf tracks around the lodge. There are many streams/lake within a half hour of the property that are sure to please both the veteran fisherman and the young novice. Within a 1-2 hour drive of the lodge are many scenic roads that follow breathtaking landscape to historical sites rich in old west history where, with a little imagination, you can picture the cowboys and Indians who helped give this area the rugged untamed character that still exists today. There are very few areas left in America with so much history and natural beauty, where so little has changed over time, where people deeply respect the land and act as caretakers preserving nature and historical treasures for future generations to enjoy.

Hopefully, you and your family/friends will get a chance to visit Fishtail Montana and camp out at the lodge; you will be enriched by its natural setting and never forget the majestic mountains, the blue Montana sky or stars that seem like you could almost reach out and touch.
